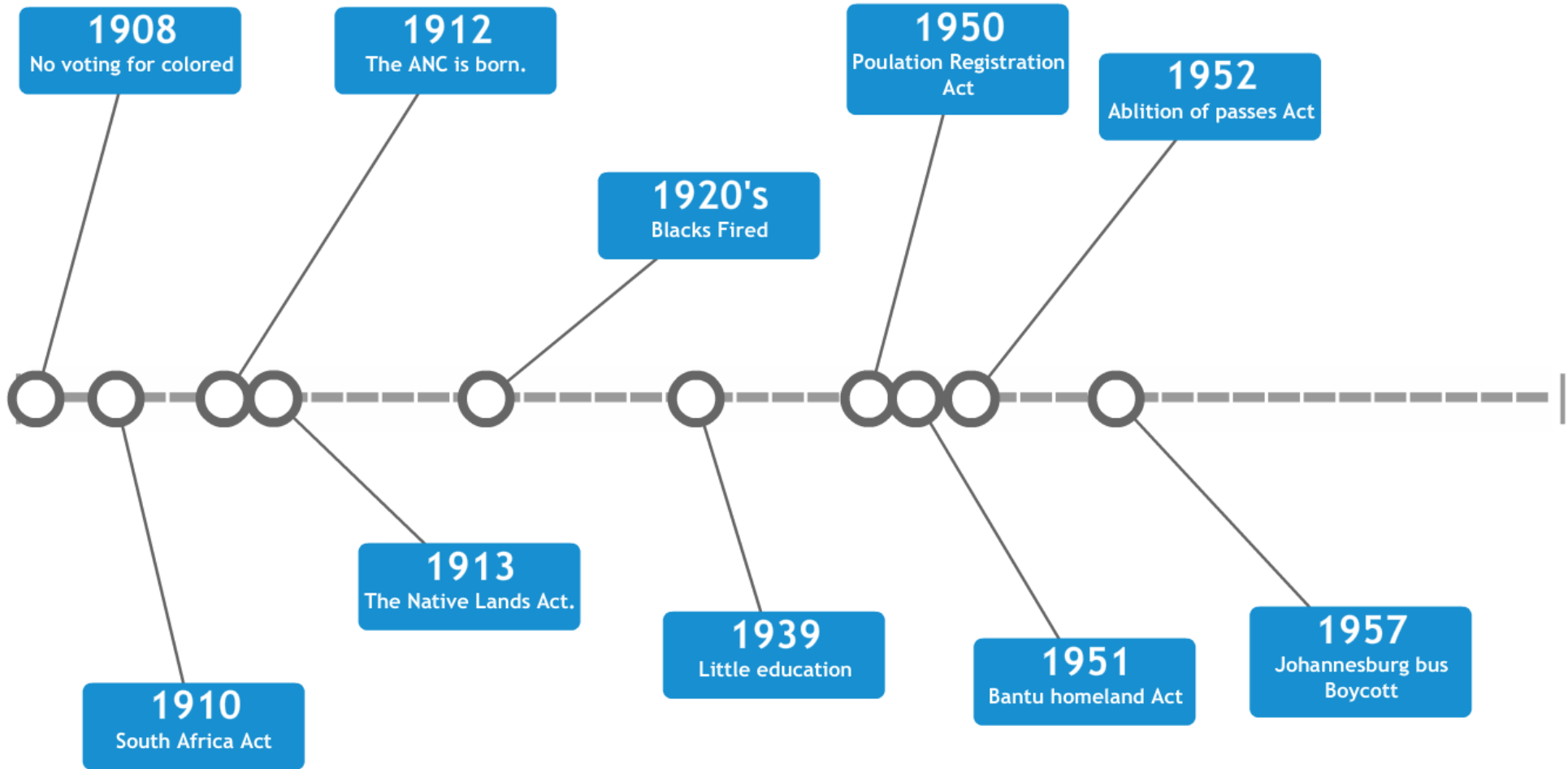

Items:

- 1908
The white government decides that blacks shouldn't be allowed to vote.
- 1910
The South Africa Act takes away all political rights of Africans.
- 1912
The ANC is formed to help the civil rights struggle for Africans.
- 1913
This gives the native Africans 7.3% of the land even though they make up 80% of the populations.
- 1920's
Blacks are fired from many jobs that are given to whites.
- 1939
Less than 30% of natives are receiving education and whites are getting 5 times blacks pay.
- 1950
The law classifies three racial classes and outlaws marriages between races.
- 1951
Lands are set aside for each race and strips millions of blacks of their citizenship in South Africa.
- 1952
This requires all Africans to have identification passes at all time. Whites didn't need these.
- 1957
The bus fares were raised in Johannesburg and the Africans couldn't afford this raise so they refused to ride the busses.
