

Items:

O 1908

The white government decides that blacks shouldn't be allowed to

O 1910

The South Africa Act takes away all political rights of Africans.

O 1912

The ANC is formed to help the civil rights struggle for Africans.

O 1913

This gives the native Africans 7.3% of the land even though they make up 80% of the populations.

O 1920's

Blacks are fired from many jobs that are given to whites.

O 1939

Less than 30% of natives are recieving education and whites are getting 5 times blacks pay.

1950

The law classifies three racial cxlasses and oulaws marriages between races.

O 1951

Lands are set aside for each race and strips millions of blacks of their citizenship in South Africa.

1952

This requires all Africans to have identification passes at all time. Whites didn't need these.

O 1957

The bus fares were raised in Johannesburg and the Africans couldn't afford this raise so they refused to ride the busses.
